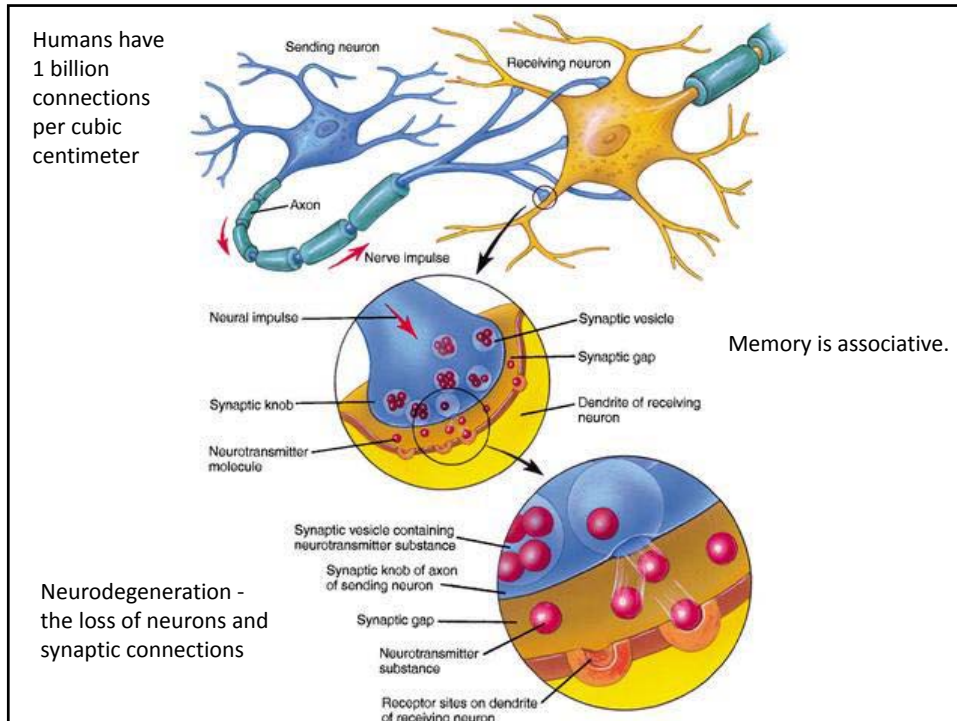


Improving Care for Alzheimer's Disease Patients at the State and National Level
